

## Instructions for connecting a microphone to an Android smartphone or tablet

---

In order to connect a microphone to an Android smartphone or tablet for recording purposes you will need the following cables and connector:

CON01ADP (Conversor Adapter cable) – this is a 3.5mm 4-pin jack connector cable with a grey microphone socket and a white headset socket.



This cable can be used on its own with Apple smartphones and tablets.

CON014PA – this is a 3.5mm 4-pin jack plug to 3.5mm 4-pin jack socket which switches the microphone connections from AHJ (American Headset Jack) convention to OMTP convention used on most Android tablets and smartphones. Note that Samsung S3 and Tablets of a similar generation

now use the AHJ convention and the Conversor adapter cable can be used on its own without the connector.



This connector can be used on its own to plug Apple headsets into Android smartphones and tablets and vice versa.

#### Instructions for use

Plug the microphone into the grey socket on the Conversor adapter cable. Plug the Conversor adapter cable into the 4-pin connector which then plugs into the smartphone or tablet. This will then switch off the on-board microphone. Adjust the volume on the Android device to give a good signal strength and then start recording.
